**Stacey Cador - Authorization to renew the Fire Department's Sick and Accident Policy with National Union Fire Insurance Company**

Stacey Cador stated, "This renewal through Riverlands Insurance Services, Inc. has an annual premium of \$45,993 which reflects a decrease of \$17,036 in the expiring premium of \$63,029. Premiums are funded through the Office of Fire Services and Administration recommends approval."

**MOTION:** Councilwoman Houston moved and Councilman Madere seconded the motion to grant administration authorization to renew the Fire Department's Sick and Accident Policy with National Union Fire Insurance Company. The motion passed unanimously.

**Stacey Cador - Authorization to renew the Juvenile Probation Officers General Liability Insurance Policy with Indian Harbor Insurance Company**

Stacey Cador stated, "This renewal through Riverlands Insurance Services, Inc. is necessary as the Juvenile Probation Officers are not covered under the Parish's professional liability policy. The renewal premium of \$4,255.73 reflects an increase of \$297.64 over the expiring premium. Premiums are funded through the Juvenile Detention Budget and Administration recommends approval."

**MOTION:** Councilman Arcuri moved and Councilwoman Houston seconded the motion to grant administration authorization to renew the Juvenile Probation Officers General Liability Insurance Policy with Indian Harbor Insurance Company. The motion passed unanimously.
