WHEREAS, Article IV, Section H (2) and (5) of the St. John the Baptist Parish Home Rule Charter permits the Parish Council to adopt a resolution when authorizing a designated person(s) to execute a previously approved contract on its behalf and/or to perform a ministerial act related to the administrative business of the Parish; and WHEREAS, Change Order No. 2 decreases the original Agreement by \$23,400.12; and, WHEREAS, the decrease is due to the removal of the scope of work for the metal roof on the drying bed building at the River Rd WWTP and adds required unforeseen demolition and reframing of the back roof at the Lions Water Treatment Plant; and, WHEREAS, Change Order No. 1 also includes liquidated damages for 55 days for delays on the project by the Contractor; and, WHEREAS, the project is funded through the Hurricane Ida Fund with FEMA reimbursement. NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the St. John the Baptist Parish Council, that Parish President Jaclyn Hotard is hereby duly authorized and empowered on behalf of the St. John the Baptist Parish Council to execute Change Order No. 2 between St. John the Baptist Parish and Roofing Solutions, LLC. WHEREAS, the estimated cost of this Amendment is \$61,241.85 and will be funded through a Louisiana Department of Health (LDH) Drinking Water Revolving Loan. NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the St. John the Baptist Parish Council, that St. John the Baptist Parish is hereby authorized to amend the Professional Services Agreement between St. John the Baptist Parish and Burk-Kleinpeter, Inc. The motion passed unanimously.

WHEREAS, Article IV, Section H (2) and (5) of the St. John the Baptist Parish Home Rule Charter permits the Parish Council to adopt a resolution when authorizing a designated person(s) to execute a previously approved contract on its behalf and/or to perform a ministerial act related to the administrative business of the Parish; and WHEREAS, MSMM Engineering, LLC. of Metairie, LA has been selected as the

Engineer for the Wastewater System Data Collection and Assessment Project; and, WHEREAS, the Wastewater Collection System in the Maple Loop area has presented many maintenance issues due to deteriorating lines and manholes; and, WHEREAS, the Engineer will provide smoke testing and assessment of the Collection System as well as recommendations for the rehabilitation of the System. WHEREAS, the estimated cost of the Agreement is \$48,570 and will be funded through the Wastewater Fund with reimbursement through an EPA Lake Pontchartrain Basin Restoration Grant. NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the St. John the Baptist Parish Council, that St. John the Baptist Parish is hereby authorized to enter into a Professional Services Agreement with MSMM Engineering, LLC. for the Wastewater System Data Collection and Assessment Project. The motion passed unanimously.

Jaclyn Hotard/Joseph Savoie - Resolution - R23-159 - A Resolution authorizing St. John the Baptist Parish President to execute Change Order No. 4 with LA Contracting Enterprise, L.L.C. for the Ruddock Water System Elevation of Electrical Components Project

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the St. John the Baptist Parish Council, that Parish President Jaclyn Hotard is hereby duly authorized and empowered on behalf of the St. John the Baptist Parish Council to execute Change Order No.4 between St. John the Baptist Parish and LA Contracting Enterprise, L.L.C. The motion passed with 8 yeas and 1 against (Torres).

the Baptist Parish Council, that Parish President Jaclyn Hotard is hereby duly authorized and empowered on behalf of the St. John the Baptist Parish Council to sign and execute the Assignment from Metro Service Group. The motion passed with 8 yeas and 1 abstaining (Schnyder).
