## **WORDS TO KNOW**

#### **♦** Federal Tax ID Number

• Often referred to as an Employer Identification Number (EIN). This number is used by the IRS to identify your business entity.

#### **♦ State Sales Tax ID Number**

• The Louisiana Department of Revenue decides if a business needs to collect sales tax and obtain a sales tax ID number.

#### **♦** Occupational License

• Grants a business permission to operate in a specified geographical area.

#### **♦** Certificate of Occupancy

• Ensures the business property is properly zoned and the business building is safe to occupy.

#### **♦** Worker's Compensation

• Mandatory insurance coverage that all employers operating in Louisiana must provide their employees.

### **♦** Unemployment Tax

• A tax employers must pay to assist in providing benefits to unemployed workers who are eligible to claim unemployment insurance.
