NOTICE TO BIDDERS:

This Addendum shall be considered part of the Contract Documents for the same above-mentioned project as though it had been issued at the same time and incorporated integrally therewith. Where provisions of the following supplementary data differ from those of the original Contract Documents, this Addendum shall govern and take precedence.

Acknowledge receipt of the addendum by inserting its number on the Bid Form of the Bid Documents. Failure to do so will cause the bid response to be rejected.

Bidders are hereby notified that they shall make any necessary adjustments in their estimates on account of this Addendum. It will be construed that each Bidder's proposal is submitted with full knowledge of all modifications and supplemental data specified herein.

QUESTIONS:

- AD2.1 Q1: Are paper copies of the bids going to be accepted and/or required at the St. John the Baptist Parish offices the morning of 16 July 2024?
 A1: *Paper copies are accepted but not required.*
- Q2: Is a bid bond required on this bid? The RFQ does not mention one but the Parish procedures call for bid bonds on projects over \$30,000.
 A2: *Bid bond not required. Performance bond will be required.*
- Q3: Are the weights available for any of the heavier items to be removed from the belt press building and pull through?
 A3: *Not available*
- Q4: Are subcontractors we plan to use on the project (including those needing training, and/or permits for handling/hauling hazardous waste) required to be listed on the bid submittal?
 A4: *No*
- Q5: What is the budget for the project?
 A5: *The budget range for the project is \$175,000 - \$200,000*
- Q6: On drawing E01, the electrical site plan, there is a note next to the digesters on the west side of the site with instructions to relocate existing light fixtures to the valve area from where the currently are. Can you confirm whether that note is part of the bid scope?
 A6: *This note is not part of the bid scope.*
